

Adele Youngs, Co-Founder and Director of Live Travel and Tours

Adele's career in the travel industry began as a university student, when she worked for a number of seasons during the holidays as a Tour Director for American high school groups travelling throughout France and Spain.

After graduating, Adele moved to London to work for a management consultancy company in their financial services division. It only took nine months, however, for her to realise that this was not the career path for her. She was subsequently recruited by one of the largest inbound tour operators in the UK, and worked in their European division arranging tours for groups travelling throughout the continent. After seven years, she was appointed Director for Europe, responsible for all the group tours organised by the company – over 2000 tours per year.

After holding this position for 5 years, in 2008 she and a colleague decided to set up their own company specialising in tours for amateur performing groups - Live Travel and Tours. Since then, the company has more than doubled in size, and was one of only three companies worldwide contracted to work with the organising committee of the London 2012 Olympic Games providing young amateur performing groups to entertain spectators in the Olympic Park and other venues.

For SYTA, Adele has served as both a Board Member and former chair of SYTA's International Committee, and is a current member of the Advisory Council of the European Tour Operators Association.
