Road Scholarship

When a class trip is planned – whether performance-based, educational, or other – teachers & program leaders can apply for a SYTA Youth Foundation "Road" Scholarship of up to \$1,000 per student.

The Road Scholarship program was created to provide eligible students and young people financial assistance so they could have the opportunity to experience the gift of travel.

Benefactor donations directly support this program.







Silver Lining

When a group of youth is affected by a common hardship, costly experiences like travel become an unattainable luxury. For these students, the SYTA Youth Foundation provides the Silver Lining they need. Each year, an all-expense paid trip is granted to help approximately 35 students & youth. The students typically come from our annual conference host city.

The Silver Lining Program's mission is to recognize deserving students who have demonstrated through their action, intention, or circumstance, the desire to expand their awareness, creating a dramatic life change.







Next Generation

Next Generation is a program funded through a grant from SeaWorld Parks & Entertainment where underprivileged youth will have the ability to engage in interactive and innovative learning experiences that teach them firsthand how to take care of animals and their wildlife habitats. The students will also learn about conservation and how they can impact their environment.


