

Board of Directors Vice President Job Description

Title: Vice President, Student & Youth Travel Association (SYTA) Board of Directors (unpaid position)

The Vice President shall preside and act as President in the case of the absence or disability of the President and assist the President when requested. Upon completion of a term as Vice President, the Vice President shall succeed to the office of President. In the event that the position of the President becomes vacant, the Vice President shall assume the office of President for the remainder of that current term and will continue as President the following term as he/she/they normally would have, had the vacancy in the President position not have occurred. The Vice President shall serve as chair of the Audit Committee and shall have such other powers and duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors and these Bylaws. (Bylaws)

Term: Three-year commitment, one year as Vice President, one year as President, and one year as Past President. The Vice President shall assume the position of the President upon completion of the full original term of office of the Vice President or upon unexpected vacancy of the President position.

Purpose: Offers support for the Board of Directors President and other leadership when needed and fulfill role of successor to President.

In addition to responsibilities of a Board of Directors member, the Vice President shall:

- Preside and act as President in the case of the absence or disability of the President
- Assist the President when requested
- Chair the Audit Committee
- Serve on the Executive Committee
- Should the position of President become vacant, fill the role of President for the remainder of that current term and continue as President the following term as they normally would have, had the vacancy not occurred.
- The current SYTA Vice President is invited to attend every BOT meeting.
