Tour and Pour at the Carrie Blast Furnaces National Historic Landmark

Address: 801 Carrie Furnace Blvd, Pittsburgh, PA 15218

Join Rivers of Steel for a guided walking tour of this integral remaining piece of the legendary Homestead Steel Works where we will explore the drama of the iron-making process – from the movement of raw materials to the tapping of the furnaces producing fiery molten iron – including the stories of the site's technology, workers and culture.

Following the abbreviated tour participants will customize a premade sand mold and create a unique 4x4 inch aluminum, one-sided design cast in solid aluminum! You'll spend time carving your design, while mixing and mingling with colleagues —witnessing each item being cast in molten aluminum reaching 1200 degrees Fahrenheit.

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

As a former industrial site, there are a few things to keep in mind to ensure an enjoyable visit:

- What to wear: The majority of each tour is outside; please dress for the weather. Additionally, the ground is uneven—sensible shoes are a must. Sneakers or boots are recommended. Open-toed shoes and high heels are prohibited.
- Hard hats are required to be worn for the duration of your tour. If you have a hard hat, please feel free to bring it. For those who need one, a hard hat will be provided and collected after the tour. Hats are disinfected between uses.
- **Restrooms** The rawness of the site is certainly part of its charm. However, that rawness also limits the creature comforts many of us are accustomed to, like running water. Portable bathrooms and wash stations are available.
- Photography: Photography is permitted. For safety reasons, videography and drones are prohibited.
- · Accessibility: Handicapped parking is available, but the grounds covered during tours are not wheelchair accessible.
- Liability: All visitors are required to sign a liability waiver and consent to be photographed (PDF).
