


#### **RBC Convention Centre**






# **BUSINESS APPOINTMENTS**

- Ratio of 4 suppliers to 1 tour operator
- Final appointment schedules will be available online on **August 7**
- Suppliers will see their appointments spread over four of the six business appointment sessions. This gives you time to attend education sessions, schedule meetings, catch up on voicemails or take a break

## TIP: RESEARCH COMPANIES WITH WHOM YOU HAVE APPOINTMENTS



Spend time researching your appointments before the show so that you will have a clear idea of who you are seeing and what you need to learn from them



Review company websites, check online profiles, see what pasthistory your company has had with each client



## **TIP: PREPARATION IS KEY**

- Prepare a 30-second elevator speech
- Prepare your materials for conference in advance
- Order extra business cards to bring with you
- In effort to be more sustainable, digital sales sheets are available within the appointment portal. Sellers be sure to upload your file! Consider bringing an iPad or Tablet to show your product, attraction or venue



#### BUSINESS APPOINTMENT ETIQUETTE

- Be on time
- End on time
- Be respectful
- Turn phone off
- Ask about a preferred time and manner in which to follow up


