RISE'S APPROACH TO TRAVELER EDUCATION

We define a conscious traveler as someone who:

- respects cultural do's and don't's
- seeks to learn about the history, culture, geopolitics, social issues of places
- acts and behaves with cultural sensitivity and cultural humility
- thinks critically about identities, privilege, positionality, relationality and power dynamics as they move through the world
- appreciates the complexities and realities of places
- makes an effort to understand local and global unjust systems and tourism's role in those systems
- identifies greenwashing and supports genuine eco- and socially conscious businesses
- Seeks out sustainable and community-led tourism initiatives
- Reflects upon the impact of their travels on host communities, natural ecosystems, and the planet

OUR EDUCATION CURRICULUM

- Teachers RISE Certificate Program
 - for educators and tour operators who design tours for students
- Study Abroad Pre-Departure Program
 - for students
- RISE Flagship Certificate Program in Sustainability and Anti-Oppression in Travel

TEACHERS RISE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Teachers RISE Certificate Program is a 10-hour online program for educators, parents, and tour operators who design educational travel experiences for youth and students. The program offers a comprehensive overview of attitudes and values that have shaped, and continue to shape travel today, and provides participants with the tools to critically examine whether their existing student travel programs reinforce or challenge these attitudes. Participants will learn how to prepare students to understand and experience travel in ways that are not only enriching to themselves but also beneficial to host communities and ecosystems.

By the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- Design study tours/educational travel experiences with sustainability and justice in mind;
- Assess their current sustainability efforts through a holistic lens;
- Equip youth and students to navigate cultural differences with respect and humility;
- Empower youth and students to engage with their host communities in a respectful and meaningful way;
- Support students throughout their journey, fostering a transformative experience that benefits both students and host communities.

TEACHERS RISE PROGRAM FORMAT

- 10-hour asynchronous program to be completed within 2 months
- 9 lessons grouped into 3 modules
- Pre-recorded videos, suggested readings, Teachers RISE workbook, discussion forum (a requirement for the certification)
- Free access to a dual-narrative virtual tour by Mejdi Tours (organized 1-2x a year)
- 1 interactive live session per quarter where participants have the opportunity to meet with their instructors and peers to discuss the program content and their capstone project ideas
- Optional capstone project (a requirement for the certification)





PRICING

Teachers RISE Certificate Program

- Full tuition: US \$375

Tiered-Pricing Model
