Tentative Itinerary
August 28-30**

Day 1: Tuesday, August 28

- 10:00am** **Depart for Gettysburg**
Start your journey to Gettysburg with a taste of our countryside, featuring homemade apple cider donuts and fresh apple cider from Hollabaugh Bros. Orchard & Farm Market.
- 12:00pm** **Lunch at the Refectory with Biggerstaff's Catering**
Enjoy lunch where the 1st day of the battle took place.
- 1:30pm** **Seminary Ridge Museum – “Mending the Wounded” Program & Cupola Tour**
At the Seminary Ridge Museum, experience an interactive program that gives groups insight into what it would have been like for a school to be turned into a Civil War hospital.
- 3:45pm** **Check into the NEW Best Western Gettysburg**
Located right downtown on Steinwehr Avenue with a breakfast room that overlooks the battlefield, the new Best Western is a great fit for student groups.
- 4:00pm** **Free Time to Explore Downtown Gettysburg**
With tons of different shops, restaurants, boutiques, etc., Downtown Gettysburg is a great option for free time or for a meal on your own.
- 6:30pm** **Opening Reception & Dinner at the Dobbin House Tavern**
Your first night in Gettysburg kicks off at the Dobbin House, the oldest, most historic home in Gettysburg. You will be entertained with period music, fireside stories and Civil War magic, interactive improv and living history.

Day 2: Wednesday, August 29

- 9:30am** **Gettysburg Heritage Center – Civilian Stories Interactive Program**
The second day of touring starts at the Gettysburg Heritage Center, an interactive museum that gives insight to what the civilian side of the battle was like, as well as an orientation to the battlefield itself. You will also get a taste of their White Glove Artifact experience with the Adams County Historical Society.
- 11:00am** **Shriver House Museum**
Listen to the story of one family, the Shrivvers, and learn about how they were impacted by the Civil War and Battle of Gettysburg during a restored house tour by a period-dressed docent.



- 12:15pm** **Lunch at Hickory Bridge Farm with “Fact or Fiction” Program**
Enjoy a family-style served lunch at Hickory Bridge Farm, a family-owned restaurant in a beautifully restored bank barn. After lunch, partake in the Fact or Fiction program by the American Stories Historic Walking Tours & Programs.
- 3:00pm** **Farnsworth House – In Their Shoes Program**
After lunch, you will visit the Farnsworth House to experience the In Their Shoes program, which is conducted by a Civil War soldier in full battle dress. During the program you will observe a day in the life of a soldier and will even be given your very own soldier identity for the program.
- 4:45pm** **Free Time to Explore Downtown Gettysburg**
With tons of different shops, restaurants, boutiques, etc., Downtown Gettysburg is a great option for free time or for a meal on your own.
- 7:00pm** **A Night at the Museum – featuring Dinner and Living History Entertainment**
For the final night in Gettysburg, you will get to experience the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum & Visitor Center in a new light. Enjoy dinner, living history entertainment and the “What in the World is a Cyclorama?” program where you will get to see the infamous cyclorama painting up close.
- 10:00pm** **Ghostly Images Tour of Jennie Wade House**
Get a taste of the haunted side of Gettysburg with a tour of the Jennie Wade House. The tour begins by traversing the grassy slopes of East Cemetery Hill. You will hear curious tales of ghostly soldiers, heartbroken women, poltergeists and other assorted ghostly encounters. For the second half of the tour, you will enter the same doorway through which a bullet passed on July 3, 1863, killing young Jennie Wade and making her the only civilian to be killed during the battle of Gettysburg.

Day 3: Thursday, August 30

- 8:30am** **Check Out & Depart the Best Western Gettysburg**
- 9:00am** **Breakfast at Wyndham Gettysburg with Living History Entertainment**
The final day of our tour begins at the Wyndham Gettysburg, featuring a short tour of the property, breakfast and entertainment by General & Mrs. Lee to wrap up the tour.
- 10:30am** **Depart for Baltimore, MD**
After concluding our time in Gettysburg, we will head back to Baltimore, arriving by 12:00pm.
